specimens from all over the globe. It also features many inspirational memorials as well as a museum honoring Westchester County veterans. When walking through the scenic paths, you'll pass a 1933 three-story Colonial-style home that was modeled after George Washington's Virginia residence, Mount Vernon. There's also a bird sanctuary donated by the Lasdon family.



Now, the Friends of Lasdon consists of civic-minded individuals from all over the county and works to develop public interest, participation, and financial support to keep the Gardens beautiful. Volunteers help with work in the greenhouse and staff the plant shop, with the proceeds going to help support the Lasdon Public Gardens and its programs.

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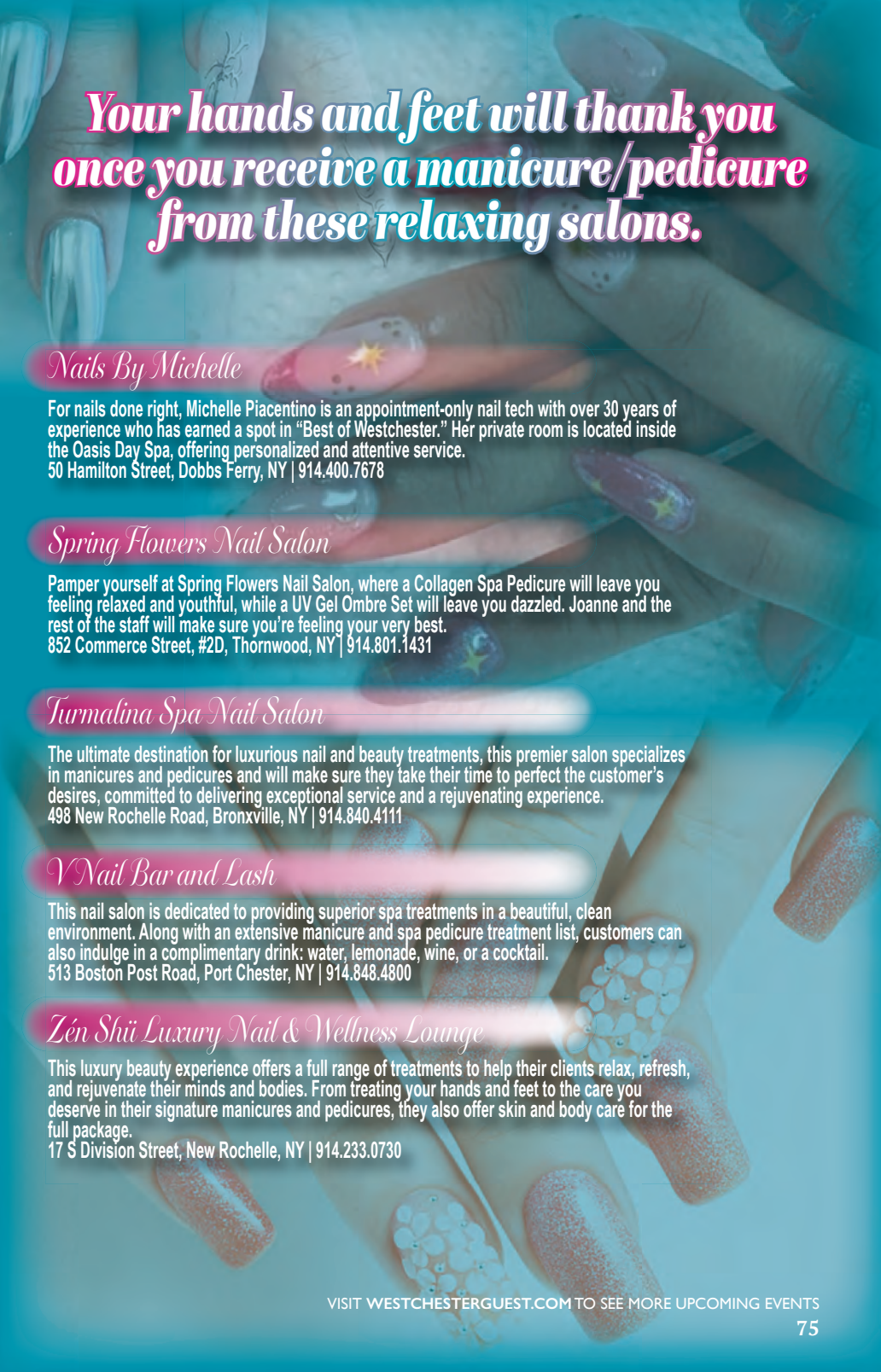
